Characteristics

In an addictive or depressed family system, the disease becomes the organizing principle. The affected person becomes the center figure from which everyone else organizes their behavior by adopting certain roles. Sometimes it is one role, sometimes it is a combination of roles

Role 1: The Addict/Alcoholic

Role 2: The Hero

Role 3: The Mascot

Role 4: The Lost Child

Role 5: The Scapegoat

Role 6: The Caretaker/Enabler

Eventually the patterns and role-playing become compulsive and the family members take these behaviors into every other relationship.

In order to heal, family members must break through the wall of delusion, accept that this is a disease, recognize your own feelings, strive for recovery of the whole person. The same principles apply to the chemically dependent person. Together, families and patients should be willing to share feelings, accept and forgive, work toward rebuilding a family system.
